1 Some cities are allowing non-citizens to vote. Would you favor or oppose allowing people who are not U.S. citizens to vote in your local elections?*

2 Congress recently rejected, with broad bi-partisan support, a Washington, D.C., law that allowed non-U.S. citizens to vote in local elections. Do you favor or oppose Congress's action to stop non-citizens from voting in our nation's capital?*

50%	Strongly favor
19%	Somewhat favor
12%	Somewhat oppose
11%	Strongly oppose
8%	Not sure

Methodology

The survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted for ACV on March 9-10, 2023. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by gender, age, and race.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
