2024 General Election

July 2023

Survey conducted July 17 through July 19, 2023. 940 likely 2024 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2024 General Election.

Margin of Error is +/-3% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

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Q1: Do you approve or disapprove of Joe Biden's job performance as President?

Approve: 41%
Disapprove: 54%
Unsure: 5%

Q2: Do you approve or disapprove of Greg Abbott's job performance as Governor of Texas?

Approve: 50%
Disapprove: 45%
Unsure: 5%

Q3: Do you believe that only US citizens should be able to vote in Texas elections? Or, do you believe that non-citizens should also have the right to vote in some Texas elections?

Only US citizens should be able to vote in Texas elections: 82%
Non-citizens should be able to vote in some Texas elections: 12%
Unsure: 6%

Q4: A state constitutional amendment has been introduced in the Texas Legislature that would clarify that only citizens of the United States are eligible to vote in all state and local Texas elections. If two-thirds of both houses of the legislature approve the measure, called the Texas Citizen-Only Voting Amendment, it will appear on the ballot for voters to decide. Do you support or oppose this amendment?

Strongly support: 67%
Somewhat support: 14%
Somewhat oppose: 6%
Strongly oppose: 5%
Undecided: 8%
