Q6: Non-citizens are currently voting in 21 cities across the U.S., including San Francisco, California; Burlington, Vermont; and Washington, DC, our nation's capital. *Does hearing this make you more or less likely to support the proposed constitutional amendment?*

Q7 : Opponents of the amendment say it is unnecessary because non-citizens are not currently voting in any city in Arkansas. Does hearing this make you more or less likely to support the proposed constitutional amendment?

Q8 : Supporters of the amendment say liberal cities could allow non-citizens to vote unless the state constitution is clear that only U.S. citizens can vote in Arkansas elections. *Does hearing this make you more or less likely to support the proposed constitutional amendment?*

Q9 : Opponents of the amendment say it may whip up hatred of immigrants or confuse naturalized citizens about their right to vote. Does hearing this make you more or less likely to support the proposed constitutional amendment?
