Survey conducted April 21 through April 22, 2025. 706 likely voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match turnout demographics for the 2026 General Election. Margin of Error is +/-3.7% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.



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Q1: Generally speaking, do you believe the state of Texas is headed in the right direction, or is it going off on the wrong track?

Right direction: 45%
Wrong track: 45%
Not sure: 10%

Q2: Overall, do you approve or disapprove of Governor Abbott's job performance?

Approve: 52%
Disapprove: 41%
Not sure: 7%

Q3: In the 2024 election, did you vote for:

Donald Trump: 55%
Kamala Harris: 43%
Other: 1%
Don't remember: 1%

Q4: Overall, do you approve or disapprove of President Trump's job performance?

Approve: 51%
Disapprove: 44%
Not sure: 5%

Q5: Do you believe that only US citizens should be able to vote in Texas elections? Or do you believe that non-citizens should also have the right to vote in some Texas elections?

Only US citizens should be able to vote in Texas elections: 88%
Non-citizens should be able to vote in some Texas elections: 7%
Not sure: 5%



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Q6: A state constitutional amendment has been introduced in the Texas Legislature that would clarify that only citizens of the United States are eligible to vote in all state and local Texas elections. If two-thirds of both houses approve the measure, called the Texas Citizen-Only Voting Amendment, it will appear on the ballot for voters to decide. Do you support or oppose this amendment?

Q7: Supporters of the proposed amendment say amending the Texas constitution to prohibit non-citizens voting in local elections is necessary to ensure Texas cities are governed by the will of its citizens. Nearly two dozen cities across the country have allowed some form of non-citizen voting. Does this make you more likely or less likely to support the amendment?

Q8: Opponents of the proposed amendment say the measure is unnecessary, because non-citizens are currently not allowed to vote anywhere in Texas. Does this make you more likely or less likely to support the amendment?

Q9: Supporters of the proposed amendment say Texas home rule cities could allow non-citizen voting under current law. Just four years ago, the Dallas City Council proposed allowing non-citizens to serve on city boards and commissions. Does this make you more likely or less likely to support the amendment?

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Q10: In the last four years, 14 states have voted to approve constitutional amendments to prohibit non-citizens from voting in their state and local elections. These have passed by an average of 75% support. Does this make you more likely or less likely to support the amendment?
